The criteria for becoming an ACDS Instructor are as follows:

- Minimum of a bachelor's degree in early childhood education or a related field.
- Minimum of one year experience working directly with young children.
- Registered WV STARS trainer or be able to complete the registry process prior to instructing.

The following must be submitted for review in order to approve participation in the ACDS Instructor's Academy:

- Completed application form.
- Professional Questionnaire (section V on the application form) to be typed on a separate sheet of paper.
- Early Childhood Philosophy (section VI on the application form) to be typed on a separate sheet of paper.

- Professional résumé.
- Copy of your college transcripts.
- Two reference letters: one from an employer and one from a colleague that you have known for at least five years. The letters must be current and should contain relevant knowledge in the education field and training skills.
- Copy of your WV STARS Trainer certificate or application to become a trainer.

Some funding may be available to assist with travel and hotel expenses. If you are interested in becoming an ACDS Instructor, please return the application, required documentation, and the \$50.00 fee (payable to ACDS) by April 28, 2017.

All applications received by April 28, 2017 will be referred to the screening committee. Participants will be notified of the committee's decision on their application by the end of May. Applications received after the April 28, 2017 due date **may not** be considered for this training session.
